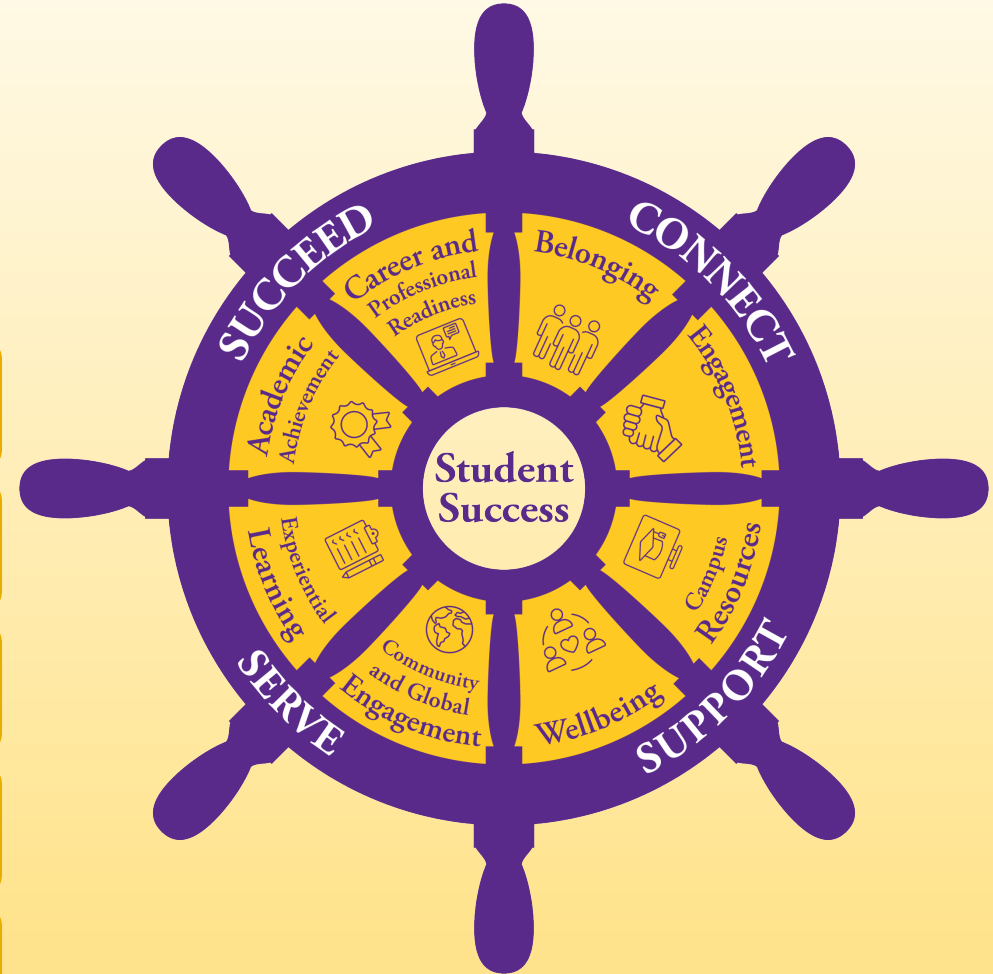

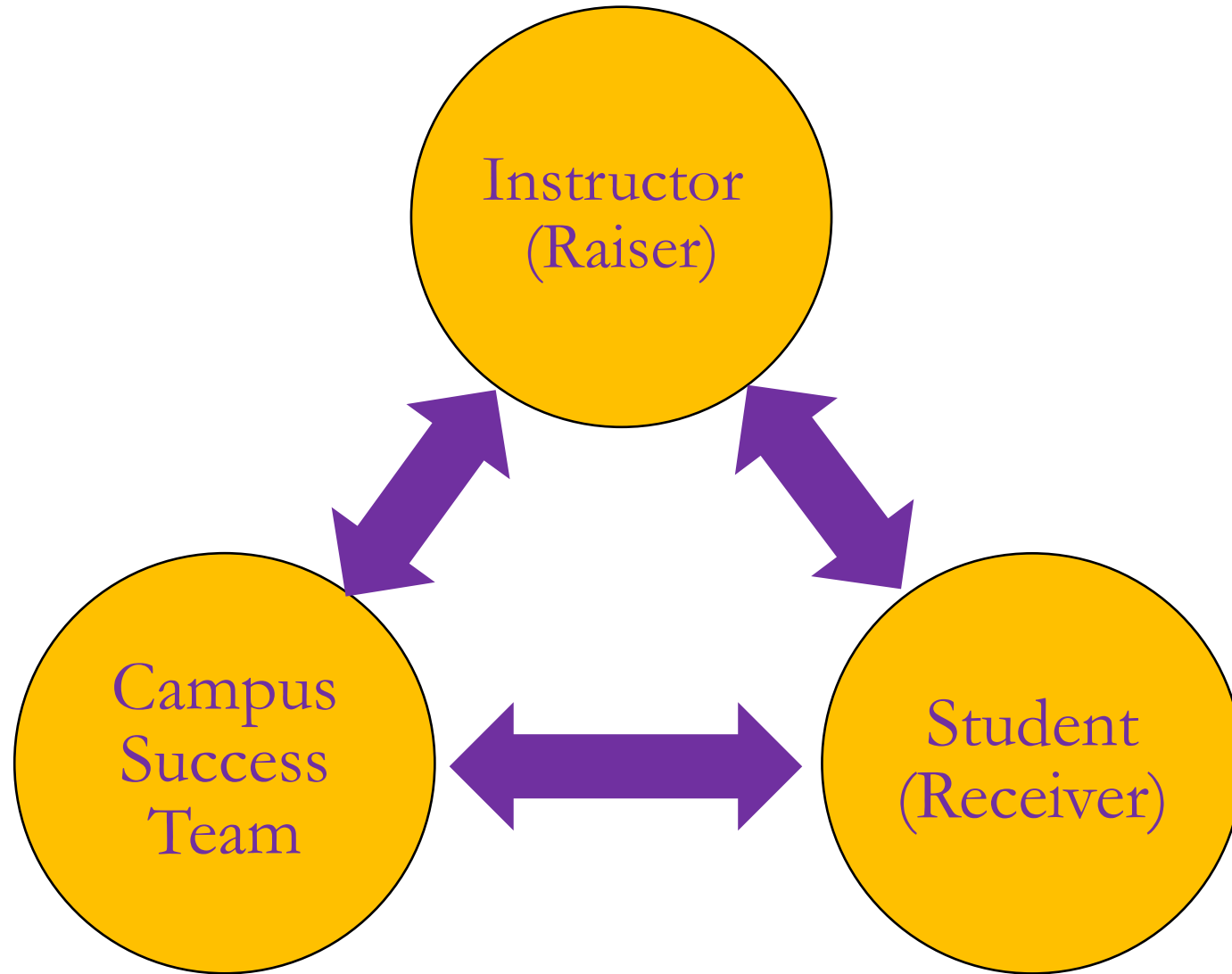

Students with documented Learning Disabilities
i.e., Dyslexia, Dysgraphia, Dyscalculia



Program Model

Comprehensive program; wrap-around supports and resources well beyond legally-required services/accommodations
Ongoing assistance to prepare students for key transition points and equip them for success at each stage of college



Supports Provided

Intensive academic assistance
Support network of professionals and peers
Life skills for college and beyond
